- 3. You will not be allowed to apply for admission if you are one of the following:
 - [i] You are registered as a student in any of the local universities.
 - [ii] A former student who has been dismissed on grounds of failure in the examinations/disciplinary action.
- 4. [a] You are required to pass the doctors examination including your chest X-Ray which has been conducted by a government medical doctor or a recognized qualified medical doctor. Please note that a University Medical Officer requires some time to examine the doctor's report and the chest X-Ray film. Your registration as a student is subject to verification by the University Medical Officer to the Registrar that you are qualified in terms of your health requirements.

Your health examination report and chest X-Ray film which has been submitted to the University will become the property of the University and you are not allowed to ask for return of the document even if you make a decision to withdraw from the University.
